- To pay interest on such unpaid amounts from August 18, 2003 until paid, at the maximum rate permitted by Guam law for pre- and post-judgment interest awards in civil cases; and
- 3. To pay the Petitioners cost of suit and reasonable attorney's fees in the matter, in an amount not less than 10% of the total of the funds otherwise payable to Plaintiffs herein.

Respondents shall file and serve their return of this writ not later than ten days after service of the writ upon counsel for Respondents. Upon receipt of Respondents return of writ, the Court shall issue such further briefing and/or scheduling orders as the Court may deem necessary.
