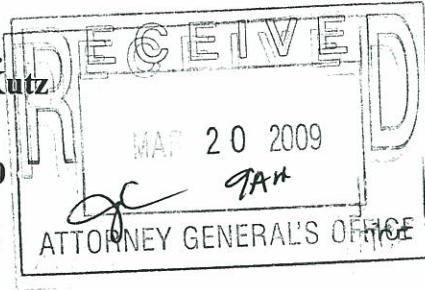

**PEREMPTORY WRIT OF  
MANDATE**

**[22 GCA Chap. 3, Fair Labor  
Standards Act]**

25 TO RESPONDENTS FELIX CAMACHO, GOVERNOR OF GUAM, LOURDES PEREZ,  
26 DIRECTOR, DEPT. OF ADMINISTRATION, NERISSA BRETANIA-SCHAEFFER,  
27 SUPERINTENDENT, GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM, AND CARLOS BORDALLO,  
28 DIRECTOR, BUREAU OF BUDGET MANAGEMENT RESEARCH:

You are hereby commanded and required:

1. To identify, compute, and pay all lawful wages, salary and benefits due to Petitioner Rector and all other similarly situated present and former teachers in the Guam Public School System, which persons constitute a class of which Rector is a representative member, for the time period August 1, 2003 to August 18, 2003, as designated in the Petition and Amended Petition herein. For purposes of this writ "to identify" members of the designated class shall include any such person's full name, social security number, last known mailing address and physical address, and

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telephone contact numbers. All such information, except names and computations of the amount due each member of the designated group shall be submitted to the Court under seal, and shall form no part of the public record in this case;

- 2. To pay interest on such unpaid amounts from August 18, 2003 until paid, at the maximum rate permitted by Guam law for pre- and post-judgment interest awards in civil cases; and
- 3. To pay the Petitioners cost of suit and reasonable attorney's fees in the matter, in an amount not less than 10% of the total of the funds otherwise payable to Plaintiffs herein.

Respondents shall file and serve their return of this writ not later than ten days after service of the writ upon counsel for Respondents. Upon receipt of Respondents return of writ, the Court shall issue such further briefing and/or scheduling orders as the Court may deem necessary.
